We support small landholders through the Gardens for Wildlife program and we also support local producers and land managers who have conservation and ecologically sustainable production goals.

Drive the roads of the Blackall Range and you will see evidence of the landscape-scale transformation led by Barung volunteers, members, staff and trainees all around you.

Barung relies on volunteers helping us by not only offering their expertise, becoming members of our Management Committee, but also collecting and donating seed from remnant native vegetation, and helping in our nursery.

Volunteers have also been the backbone of the Maleny Wood Expo and for that the current Management Committee and staff are extremely grateful.

The Maleny Wood Expo is Barung Landcare's major fundraiser for the year, and all proceeds raised from ticket sales go straight back into Barung's environmental projects and future Wood Expo events.

About the Maleny Wood Expo

Barung Landcare hosted the first Maleny Wood Expo in April 1996 at the Maleny Showgrounds. The emphasis of the Wood Expo was on the talented woodworkers hidden in the local area.

The inaugural Wood Expo ran for two days, and at the end of each day visitors were rushing up the ramp of the Showgrounds Pavilion, trying to get around in the closing minutes, because they'd heard in the Maleny township, about the stunning array of work on display by local woodworkers.

The Wood Expo has evolved in 25 years and in the early 2000s it became 'The Maleny Wood Expo: From Chainsaw To Fine Furniture'. It was named 'From Chainsaw to Fine Furniture' to reflect the variety of work from the roughest to the finest, and early organisers could not believe the response. In 2017 the name became 'The Maleny Wood Expo: From Seed to Fine Furniture', reflecting the whole sustainable timber story, from the collection of seeds, to the growing of beautiful local timber to the creation of fine furniture and stunning works of art.

Over the years the Wood Expo has expanded its environmental education and sustainable living focus, with the aim of inviting more awareness and conversation about how we interact with our beautiful natural resources and manage our impact on the planet.

What are the factors in Maleny Wood Expo's success? Firstly and most importantly – volunteers! There simply would be no Wood Expo without the enthusiastic band of over 100 volllies who are selling tickets, helping to set up and pack down the Expo, giving directions and advice and so much more! Thank you all.

Secondly – turns out size does matter! The Maleny Wood Expo is small enough to be accessible, to not have queues or huge crowds, to allow for interaction with artisans and toolmakers and large enough to have a great array of exhibitors, stallholders, speakers and entertainers...all with a family-friendly atmosphere.

And then there's the Wood Expo ethos – the commitment by everyone involved with the event to work in sustainably harvested native, weed, salvaged or recycled timbers, and ethically sourced materials.

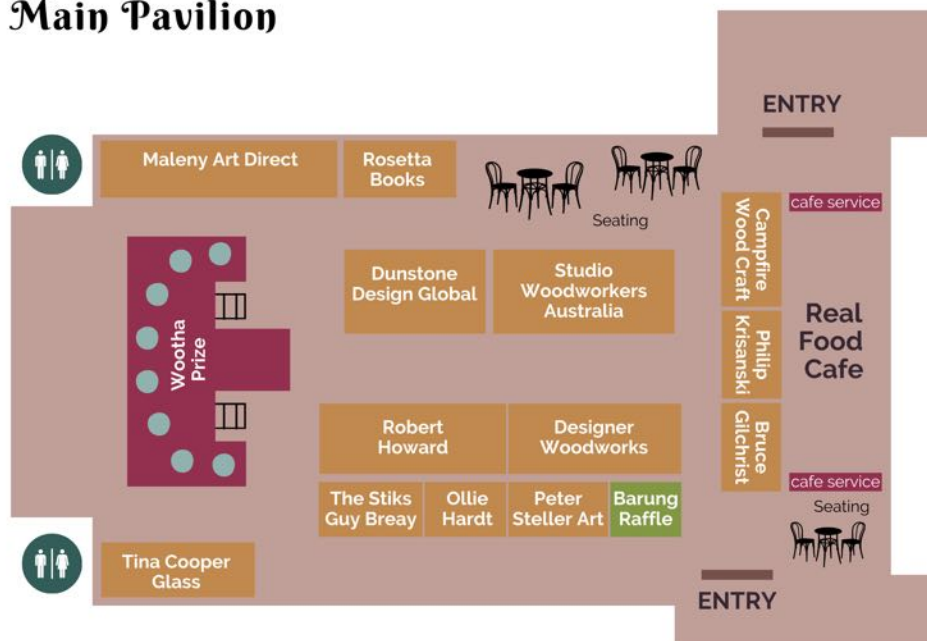

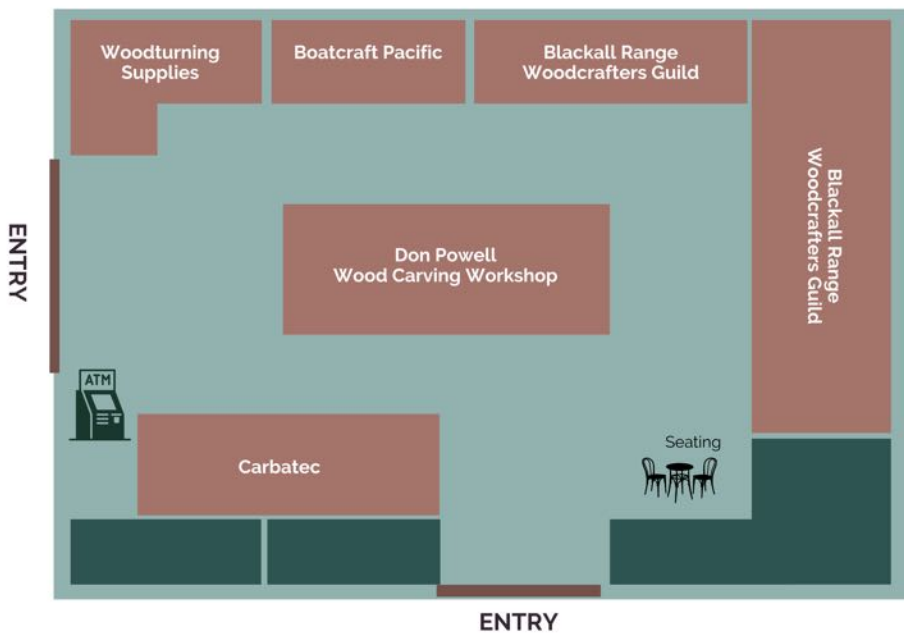

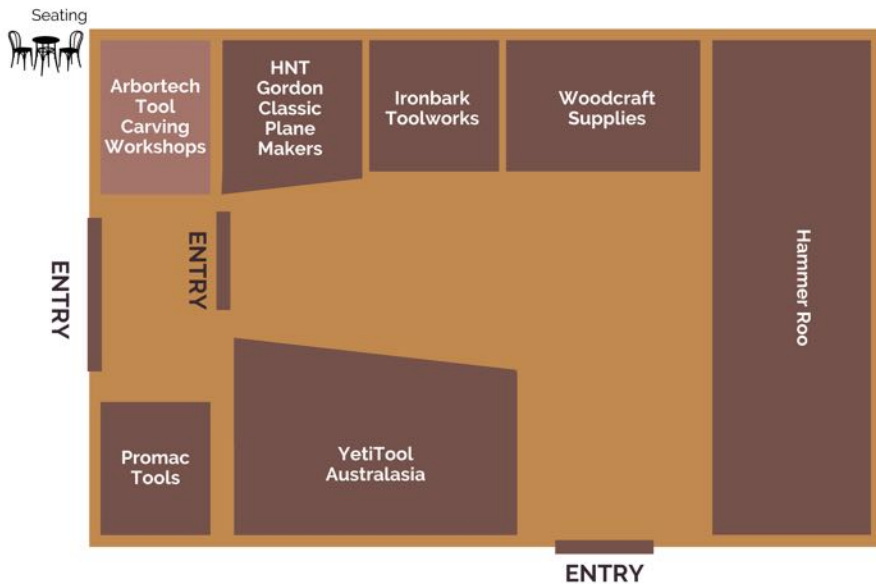
